**ORDINANCE #6.**

**PEACE AND GOOD ORDER OF TOWNSHIP/ANIMALS**

Section I:

(1) The following offenses against the peace and good order of the township of Kingston, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, is adopted, providing a penalty for the commission; such offense hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture as hereinafter set onto.

(2) That the purpose is to insure that the residents of the Town of Kingston will have public peace and good order in reference to animals and maintenance of any animal by its owner.

(3) That in addition to the requirement that each person owning a dog have a license; that no person having in his or her possession or under his or her control any animal, with the exception of farm domestic animals, shall allow the same to run at large within the township of Kingston, Green Lake County.

Section II:

(1) **Penalty Provisions: General penalty.** Any person who shall violate the provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction of such violation be subject to a penalty which shall be as follows:

**(a) First offense penalty** - any person who shall violate this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$50 together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and cost of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

**(b) Second offense penalty** - any person found guilty of violating this ordinance who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one year shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed 6 months.

**(c) Continued Violations** - each violation and each day a violation continues or occurs shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing in this ordinance shall preclude the township of Kingston from maintaining any appropriate action to remove any violation of the provision of this ordinance.

**(d) Execution against Defendant's property** - Whenever a person fails to pay any forfeiture and cost of prosecution upon the order of the court for violation of this ordinance of the Township of Kingston, the court may in lieu of ordering imprisonment of the defendant or after the defendant has been released from custody issue an execution against the property of the defendant for said forfeiture and costs.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force January 15, 1982. Passed and approved by the Town Board of the Town of Kingston, Green Lake County, WI on the 7th day of January, 1982.
